

## HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of Claddagh Plastering Ltd to promote standards of health and safety within the workforce which will lead to the avoidance or reduction in risks to health and safety and to ensure that the best practicable methods of compliance with the current legislation are achieved.

This will be achieved by the following:

- determining and implementing appropriate preventative and protective measures;
- having regard to the general principles of prevention;

- reporting prescribed accidents and dangerous occurrences to the Health & Safety Authority; and
- obtaining, when necessary, the services of a competent person to advise on health and safety.

The detailed arrangements for achieving these objectives are set out in the main body of the Safety Statement. Directors, Managers and Employees share a responsibility in ensuring their own safety while at work, while Managers and supervisors will be the role models and leaders in this process.

This Safety Statement requires the co-operation of all staff, visitors, contractors and others to enable Claddagh Plastering Ltd to discharge its responsibilities under law.

Our policy will always be to comply with the provisions of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, the Regulations made under the Act, and all appropriate and relevant Codes of Practice, Standards and Guidelines that apply to our business.

Claddagh Plastering Ltd is committed to upholding the standards outlined in this Safety Statement. Sufficient authority and resources, both financial and otherwise, will be made available to enable staff to carry out their responsibilities in a reasonable and efficient manner.

All employees will be made aware of and have access to this Safety Statement. The Safety Statement will also be available to third parties where appropriate.

*Employees are encouraged to put forward suggestions for improvement to this document. The Safety Statement will be reviewed annually, in light of experience and future developments within the organisation.*
